

Please note, Project Immune Readiness (PIR) and Immunization University (IMZU) have been identified to transition to Joint Knowledge Online (JKO). The projected date of transition is in the first quarter of FY17. Currently, Students can continue to take courses in both systems until they have been transitioned to JKO. Upon complete transition of all modules to JKO, notification will be distributed to all Services. By clicking on the link above, you will arrive at “My Immunization University.”



Click “My ImzU Transcript”



Once you can view your transcript, click on the gold ribbon next to each course you have completed, as shown below. This will open your certificate in a new window, as shown in Fig.1d. Once the certificate appears, hover over the picture and icons will appear at the bottom, which will allow you to save or print your certificate.



After clicking “Compatibility View Settings” Fig. 2c will appear. Check the “Display intranet sites in Compatibility View” as shown below. Then click close.



Click on the “Transcript” tab on the left as shown in Fig 2d.



