


Figure 1. Count and Rate of Incident Injuries*, Grafenwoehr & Army, AUG 2014-JAN 2016

Figure 2. Rate of Incident Eye and Hearing Injuries*, Grafenwoehr, AUG 2014-JAN 2016





Figure 3. Rate of Incident Upper and Lower Extremity Injuries*, Grafenwoehr, AUG 2014-JAN 2016

Figure 4. Rate of Incident Head, Spine, and Torso Injuries*, Grafenwoehr, AUG 2014-JAN 2016





Figure 5. Rate of Incident Environmental and Other/Unspecified Injuries*, Grafenwoehr, AUG 2014-JAN 2016



Figure 6. Percentage of Injured Service Members by Number of Medical Encounters - Grafenwoehr & Army, December 2015


